




## WORKPLACE HARMONY AND PROFESSIONAL ETHICS!!!






## ORGANIZING AND LEARNING INTERPERSONAL SKILLS!!!

He also believed that the tower could be used to transmit energy to aeroplanes and ships, making wireless travel possible. Tesla invested heavily in Wardenclyffe Tower However, and by 1905 the tower was nearly complete., Tesla's financial backer, J.P Morgan withdrew his support after becoming concerned about the cost of the project and the potential military applications of Tesla technology.

Despite its short life, Wardenclyffe Tower remains a symbol of Tesla's vision for a wireless future.




