### NAVRATRI CELEBRATIONS AT SANSKAR WORLD SCHOOL: A CULTURAL TRIUMPH




The festivities kicked off with an enthralling




### CAREER COUNSELLING & TEACHER'S WORKSHOP @ SANSKAR WORLD SCHOOL
